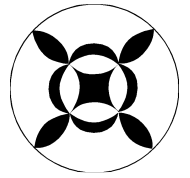

Greetings Quilters,

Speaking of sewing machines, I hope all of you are determined to make your 4 placemats for Meals on Wheels. Our goal is to deliver 400 placemats by the end of May. If each member makes just 4, we can meet that challenge! Floral, sports, patriotic, pets-- any theme will be appropriate. Placemats may be any pattern of your choice. Mine are 12" square theme print for the center with 3" borders on 2 sides. They're fast and easy. (They look cute, too!) We're counting on everyone to help out. Thanks in advance!

We're considering another charity project for Rochester General Hospital through a request from Doug Della Pietra (Director of Volunteers Services). They're looking for "adult bibs" for patients with

esophageal cancer (cancer of the throat). We'll let you know details as they're received.

The editor reminded readers about the important role our local shops hold even in this age of on-line ordering. Our local shops are there for us day in and day out whether it's for an emergency run for thread, for just the right color of fabric for a project, for classes to give us the latest techniques or simply to allow us to "fondle some beautiful fabric" on a cloudy winter day. We are blessed in Rochester to have an excellent variety of shops within a very short drive! In that spirit, don't forget about our IQC Shop Hop. We have coupons for 10 area shops and a passport that you need to have sign at each spot. If they're not claimed we'll donate them into the community. It's so nice to have our area look neat and tidy. Stop in and see for yourself. While you're there, sign out a book from our vast library. For decorating your person you will find jewelry including the wildly popular Chamilia charms for bracelets, necklaces and earrings. Also in stock are Donna Sharp quilted handbags and accessories.
