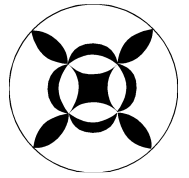

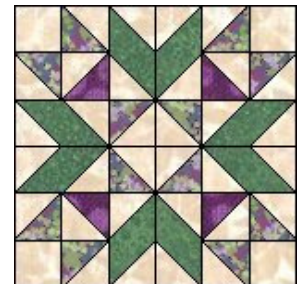

Unfinished sized:  
tumbler: 6 1/2" x 6 1/2"  
isocoles triangle: 5" x 6"  
parallelogram: 3 3/4" x 3 1/2"

Finished sizes:  
chisel: 3" x 6"  
1/2 square triangles: 2", 3", 6"  
drunkard's path: 3 1/2" (makes 1/4 block)  
Squares: 2", 4"  
Triangle: 3" x 6"
