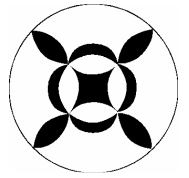

For almost 34 years, Kitty Keller has offered fine fabrics for sale at her shop, Patricia's Fabric House. These include quilting cottons as well as fashion and special occasion fabrics. In addition the shop also offers a complete line of Elna sewing machines and sergers.

Patricia's boasts over 4,000 bolts of fabric with collections by Kona Bay, Moda, Hoffman and RJR among others. They also have a great selection of batiks, orientals and, novelty prints. Unique threads and

unusual buttons, books and notions are stocked as well.

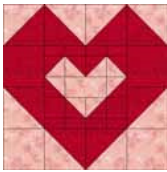
