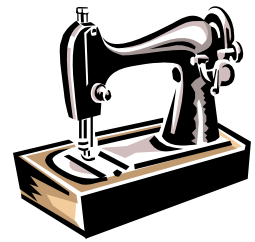

### **Quilt Show Entries**

Thanks to all who have returned their entry forms! There is still time. I will accept your entry forms at the Sept. 25<sup>th</sup> meeting,

or you may mail them to me no later than Oct. 1st. If you need entry forms, they are on the web site. Or you can call me. (266-5283) and I will send one out to you.

Just a few reminders---

We can accept only quilts that are finished and that have not been shown at a previous Irondequoit Quilt Club show. You must attach a label - with your name on it - as proof that the quilt belongs to you. Basting it on the back is okay. A sleeve is not necessary as we use hangars to hang them. I will be accepting quilts at my home (2304 Titus Ave) October 15-17. (If that is a problem - call and let's work something out). You will receive the top part of your entry form (with your assigned entry number on it) when you drop off your quilt. This will be your receipt to retrieve your item. Hold on to it!! Quilt pickup will begin approximately 45 minutes after the show is over. No items will be handed out until everything is taken down, folded, bagged and alphabetized. If you are unable to pick up your things, be sure you designate someone to do it for you. You must have your receipt - no exceptions!!
